Call for Workshops

Please note: A workshop is not simply a long paper! A workshop should involve participants in active engagement, sharing and learning. This can take any number of forms, for example through guided exercises (writing, drawing, meditation or reflective exercises), through discussion and small group work, and so on.

Workshops can be 40 minutes or 80 minutes duration (please specify).

We welcome 200 – 300 word abstracts for workshops. Please:

- **make clear how you intend to involve participants in the workshop, and what the outcome of the workshop will be.**
- **state minimum and maximum number of participants to make the workshop viable.**
- **submit your abstract as a word document and include your name, affiliation, geographical location (so we can know your time zone), title of workshop and email address, and a brief autobiographical sketch of the workshop leader(s).**
- **email your proposal to workshops@biapt.org**

Deadline for submissions is 1 May 2022 by 5pm BST.

We will inform those whose workshops have been accepted by 1 June 2022.
